

PAYMENT IN LIEU OF TRANSPORTATION PROCEDURES

Payment in lieu of transportation is a payment made to families of students attending a non-public school whose bus route, that would otherwise qualify for district transportation, is declared impracticable by the Board of Education. Once declared impracticable, those families qualify for this payment. The amount is set by the Ohio Department of Education. If a bus route to a non-public school is not declared impracticable and transportation services are offered, families do NOT qualify for this payment.

Following is a timeline of events associated with the payment in lieu of transportation:

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| By June 15 | Parent/Guardian submits application for payment in lieu of transportation payment and the District verifies the student lives within the NAPLS school boundary. |
| | Once school of residence is verified then the school of attendance is contacted for student enrollment verification. |
| | The school of attendance then verifies the student attended their school and the duration of their attendance. |
| | Once all verifications are received from the school of attendance, student names are submitted to the Board of Education for Approval |
| By August 15 | Board of Education approves payment in lieu of resolution which includes student/parent names |
| By August 31 | Payment will be issued to the parent of the qualifying student once board approved. |
