

2019-2020 Pay-to-Participate Fee Information

The New Albany-Plain Local School District requires a fee for student participation in interscholastic sports and extracurricular activities. The fee for high school athletics is \$425 per season. The fee for middle school athletics is \$225 per season. The fee for middle or high school extracurricular activities is \$125 per activity.

We recognize that the participation fees may constitute a financial burden for students and their families. An installment payment plan and/or student scholarship for financial hardship or extenuating circumstances is available to help enable student participation, when needed.

Full payment, installment payment, or an approved scholarship amount is required for each student prior to the first official contest in any sport or official meeting of any activity. A student will not be permitted to participate after the first official contest or meeting if an approved payment has not been received. Further, each student's fee account must be current to be eligible to participate. Payments are submitted electronically via each student's PayForIt.net account. The deadline to make the payment in full, the first installment payment, and/or have an approved scholarship is outlined below for each season.

Note: The pay-to-participate fee will not appear in PayForIt until the coach/advisor has submitted the official roster for student participation. Coaches/advisors will notify students when the fee has been loaded into PayForIt.

Payment Information

Pay-to-participate fees are paid electronically via [PayForIt.net](https://payforit.net). Payment may be made via a debit/credit card or ACH transaction. Directions on how to log-in or create a PayForIt account may be found [here](#).

For families electing an installment payment plan option for sports or extracurricular activities, the pay-to-participate fee schedule is detailed below.

(Note: Failure to pay by the installment due dates will result in not being able to participate until payment is made. Any outstanding payments will result in non-participation of any future extracurricular activities until an approved payment is received.)

Refunds will be determined at the discretion of the NAPLS Administration. Refunds may be pro-rated if a student is injured and unable to complete the season or if the student transfers from the district. The athlete must provide medical verification to the Principal or Athletic Director signed by a physician for consideration of a refund or reduction of a fee balance due for an injury that prevents completion of a specific season. No other refunds will be given. **Academic ineligibility does not qualify for a refund or any fee balance reduction.**
