Graduation Robe Color Change

For the Class of 2020, we will move to a single color, maroon cap and gown for all students. A proposal was created by Senior team to change the color of graduation gowns after research was conducted. The proposal was accepted by the administrative office as long as certain criteria were met adding gold to other recognitions. Therefore along with the change in gown color, we will also be adding gold stoles for valedictorian/salutatorian and gold cords for Summa Cum Laude. This change is brought about for the following reasons:

- Unity - Wearing one color on graduation day will unite the graduating class with a sense of pride and togetherness. They will feel as though they are one group that has achieved their goal of graduating high school together.
- New Albany Branding - Our district has created branding with dark maroon and vegas gold. The bright yellow gowns do not match the approved style guide for the district. New Albany's vegas gold is not an available option. The standardization of the maroon robe will allow "gold" to be incorporated into recognition for the valedictorian, salutatorian, and other honors via stoles or cords.
- District Core Values - One of our district's core values is "Stronger Together", wearing the same color of robe on graduation day will exemplify and promote this idea of oneness within our senior class.

Students who wish to opt out of AP tests should see their AP teacher and complete an opt-out form. If students do not opt out, a test will be ordered and the restocking fee for an unused in May 2020 is \$40.00.

ASVAB on November 6

The ASVAB Career Exploration Program is the only career planning resource that allows students to explore multiple paths to success - college, certificates, apprenticeships, licensure programs, or the military - all in one place! It is a timed multi-aptitude test which assesses a student's ability to learn new skills and is a predictor of success in training and education programs regardless of post-secondary intention. The ASVAB provides valuable feedback for all students whether they are considering military service or not!

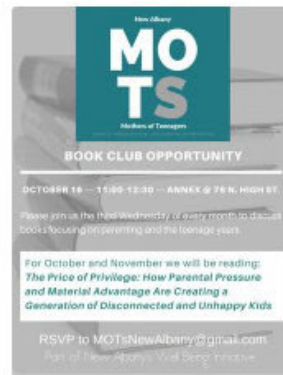
